FORMER LSU BASEBALL STAR MIKIE MAHTOOK AWARDS GRANT TO AID LOUISIANA FLOOD RELIEF EFFORTS

August 23, 2016 (Baton Rouge, LA) – Former LSU Baseball star and current Tampa Bay Rays outfielder **Mikie Mahtook** announced today that the **Mikie Mahtook Foundation** has awarded a \$5,000 grant to support Baton Rouge residents affected by the recent flooding devastation. The grant was given to the LSU Foundation, which set up a student fund designated for flood victims.
